1. * In terms of the Putonghua requirement, *LANG 1005 Elementary Putonghua* (or its equivalence as defined by the University) is the prerequisite for the Summer Sojourn, and we require all China Studies majors to pass *LANG 1005 Elementary Putonghua* in the second semester of the third year before the summer sojourn. In addition, China Studies majors are required to get at least a B grade in the Putonghua course taken during the Summer Sojourn. Students who fail to meet this requirement have to pass *LANG 1006 Intermediate Putonghua* or its equivalence as defined by the University.
 2. **Field Camp is conducted during the second semester of Year 3.
 3. *** Summer Sojourn is conducted during the summer at the end of Year 3.
 4. #For Advanced China Studies courses, students are required to take at least 6 units with CHSG prefix.
