## ■ Geography Field Camp to Cambodia (22-28 May 2016)

The annual departmental field camp to Cambodia was successfully held during the period from 22-28 May 2016. The overseas field camp serves as an introduction to fieldwork, allowing students to develop their observational power and investigation skills, and provide meaningful analysis for various geographical inquiries in real-world situations.
