
GCAP3027 GE Capstone Interdisciplinary Independent Study of Environmental or Social Issues

Double-counting Guidelines

- 1. All students are required to take a 3-unit Interdisciplinary GE Capstone Course or an Interdisciplinary Independent Study (GE Capstone) under the new GE Programme.
- 2. Students who major in BSSc GEOG may choose to take GCAP3026/GCAP3027/GCAP3145/GCAP3146 to fulfil the requirements of GE Capstone and Social Sciences Common Core Experiential Learning in Action (ELA).
- 3. If a geography major student decides to double-count a GE Capstone, he/she has to take any 3-unit major elective course to make up the 3 units to fulfil graduation requirements. Then he/she can be exempted from taking SOSC3005 or SOSC3006 (ELA).
- 4. Students who wish to minor in Geography are required to fulfil 15 units of Minor Elective courses, including at least two level 2 elective courses and at least two level 3/4 elective courses. Upon completion of GCAP3026/GCAP3027, a level 3/4 elective course will be exempted. Students only need to fulfil 12 units for the minor programme and apply to the Academic Registry for approval.

Points to note:

- GE Capstone CANNOT be counted as free electives (Students are reminded to avoid taking more than one GE Capstone).
- In fulfilling the overall units required for graduation, the units of double-counted courses can only be counted ONCE.

How to apply?

• Students will be able to apply for double-counting in their final year and Academic Registry will inform students of the details via email in January or March. Students can submit an application via BUniport (Studies > My e-Application > Registration & Study Progression > Apply for Double-counting GE Capstone towards Major Requirements).
